### 1902

Foley-Williams sewing machine, player piano and organ manufacturing company is located on West Station Street, on land purchased from Three-I Railroad.

#### 1914

Sears Roebuck & Company purchases the defunct factory and uses it to house the E-Z Est Way Stove Works.

### 1987

Under the leadership of Max
Hoover, the former Roper
corporate headquarters
building is donated to Riverside
Medical Center

### 1908


McIntyre Watch Company produces fine watches and scientific instruments.


### 1958

Becomes the Geo. D. Roper Corporation. By the 1960s the assembly line at the Kankakee Roper factory was one of the largest in the world.













Declining need for Inpatient Acute Care Beds

More care being performed in outpatient settings


Care being diverted from Emergency Departments to Immediate Care Centers




# **EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT**




# Cardiology Expansion

- 6 dedicated exam rooms


### Cardiac Rehab

- Dedicated space adjacent to cardiology exam rooms


