## **Keynote Presenters**



Erik Barnlund grew up in nearby Donovan and graduated from Illinois Wesleyan University. He started as a web designer and later director of business development. After helping COUNTRY Financial start their first web development department, he became a consultant. Erik became co-founder and CEO of Mavidea Technology Group in 2007. Mavidea provides IT Management and Web

Design Services. Now with 28 employees, Mavidea has become a technology powerhouse in Central Illinois and was nationally recognized with a no. 30 ranking on IngramMicro's top 500 performing technology companies in 2012. The company was also a "Top 250 IT Services provider" in CRN Magazine two years in a row. Erik has won several awards including Heartland Technology Peer Group's "Go-Giver Award" (2011).

Erik and his younger brother, Kris, also refinish Ford Broncos and sell them across the country through their business, Maxlider Ford Bronco Customs. They have six full-time and two part-time employees and continue to grow. Erik attributes the fast growth to their consistent use of Social Media and a relentless focus on maintaining a great reputation. Their Instagram & Facebook videos are testament to the fun Erik has with his business and their employees! "I'm not in it to get rich, just to build great relationships with people," he said. Erik is married to Bridget, and they reside in Bloomington, with their three children.


