






PEMBROKE TOWNSHIP NATURAL GAS LINE

- 126,730 ft. (24 miles) of natural gas line have been installed in Pembroke Township.
- 8 residential, 4 commercial properties have connected to the pipeline.
- Phase 1: 100% complete
 Phase 2: 86% complete pending additional land rights
 Phase 3: 39% complete
- \$140,000 in initial grant funds received by the County. Next funding round expected in August.






