Hispanic Students Attending College

Kankakee Community College has reported that of their 2,669 enrolled students 22.7% are Hispanic.

Secondly- of their 482 Adults for GED/ESL

68.9% are Hispanic.

KCHP has provided sponsorships to Adults getting assistance to get their GED/ESL Certifications.

Olivet Nazarene University has reported of their 3,500 students 13% are Hispanic.

What are we doing to help:

Providing Scholarships

Offering financial assistance to help cover tuition, books, and college-related expenses.

First-Generation Student Support

Guiding students who are the first in their families to attend college with mentorship and resources.

Partnerships with Local Schools

Collaborating with counselors and educators to identify and assist students in need.

Scholarships Granted

- Since 2004 we had been giving out 10 scholarships a year of \$1000 each. We had received so many that the amount was lowered to \$500.
- We recently raised that amount to \$1,000
- We have given out a total of 110 scholarships

Hispanic Heritage Celebrations



- We are bringing back our Hispanic Heritage Luncheon this year.
 Funds raised at this event will go towards scholarships. Date to come soon!
- We organized a Hispanic Heritage celebration in 2020. Started small with Hispanic Owned businesses as vendors at the Farmers Market and a small band playing at night at the Gazebo in Downtown Kankakee.
