A state-of-the-art 10 Gwh pack and 20 Ghw electric vehicle battery manufacturer. Gotion will also incorporate pack production and energy storage via solar power.

- Create more than 2,600 positions through 2 phases
 - Hiring to begin early 2024

REBUILD ILLINOIS

12 Projects in Kankakee County at \$263.5M

Scheduled for completion in 2023

- Rte. 102 from the Will/Kankakee County line to U.S. 45/52 in Bourbonnais Expected completion: Winter 2023
- Waldron Road over I-57 Completed
- U.S. 45/52 over Rock Creek west of Manteno Completed in June
- Illinois 115 in Kankakee Completed in July

Three projects scheduled for completion in 2024 Five projects to begin in 2025 and completed in 2027





SOUTH SUBURBAN AIRPORT

Governor Pritzker signed HB 2531 to begin search for private investors to finance and build the South Suburban Airport in Peotone.





PEMBROKE TOWNSHIP

- Natural gas connection to customers expected in next several months.
- Work continues in extending gas line.



BRADLEY

WEST BROADWAY REHAB

- \$12M rehab of West Broadway from South Washington Ave. to Kennedy Drive
- Will include narrowing of the street, raised greens, natural barriers, wider sidewalks
- Funding from Bradley business district tax will help pay for renovations
- Construction to be completed by 2026

- New \$7M, 45,000 sq. ft. Public Works facility on Village's north side.
- Police station remodel and relocation complete










